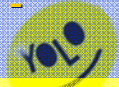

I thought I was pretty much up to date on what **All Faiths Food Bank** is doing, but I did not know that during 2015 AFFB, along with 184 organizations and agencies (including our club), had distributed over 8 million pounds of food in Sarasota and Desoto Counties to deserving children, veterans, and poor families. **Sandra Frank**, CEO of All Faiths Food Bank, also announced that AFFB has successfully raised \$1.2 million for the 2016 summer pantry program with the goal of serving 27,000 local children. She also noted that our club's efforts and fund raising capabilities made us one of the model partners in Sarasota. While 85% of the food that AFFB receives is donated, the combination of additional fresh food, storage, and transportation costs is where the \$1.2 million will be spent this summer. To all of those in our club who have worked so hard this year on behalf of both the back pack and food pantry programs, congratulations! Thanks again to Sandra for reminding us of the importance of our efforts and of our financial contributions to these programs.
