Today's Speaker: Mike Hein



Mike Hein is the Assistant Town Manager for Longboat Key, FL. Mike joined the Town in January of 2016. Under the direction of the Town Manager, Dave Bullock, they oversee the operations of the Town government that provides all basic services including Police, Fire/EMS, public works, land use planning and zoning, parks and recreation and administrative services to its citizens.

Prior to moving to the region with his wife, Anne-Marie Russell (the Executive Director, Sarasota Museum of Art), he served over 25 years in local government. Mike served as the Director of the Pima County Office of Emergency Management and Homeland Security and was formerly the City Manager for the City of Tucson. He worked for several Southern Arizona jurisdictions including Pima County, the City of Tucson, the Town of Marana, the City of Nogales, and the City of South Tucson.

Mike is a Certified Economic Development Finance Professional. He has a Master Degree in Public Administration from the University of Arizona and his B.S. is from the University of Wisconsin, Stevens Point. Mike also attended the Senior Executives in State and Local Government program at Harvard's Kennedy School of Government.
