WHEREAS, Florida is committed to empowering its residents to reach their full potential and lead healthy lives; and

WHEREAS, during these unprecedented times, it is now more important than ever for Florida's families to prioritize their health and wellness; and

WHEREAS, Poliomyelitis, mostly known as poliovirus or polio, is a disease that most commonly affects children under the age of five; and

WHEREAS, polio is usually spread from person to person through contaminated water and can attack the nervous system, sometimes leading to paralysis; and

WHEREAS, polio cases have reduced by 99 percent since 1988; and

WHEREAS, since 1985, Rotary International, a global non-profit service organization, has remained focused on eliminating polio; and

WHEREAS, World Polio Week is an opportunity to raise awareness of this disease, while working to keep other countries polio-free.
